

**ALLAMA ALHAJ HAFEZ QUARI
SYED MUHAMMAD TAYYAB SHAH (R.A)**

Blessed Birth:

Rahnumaye -e- Shariat and Tarikat, Murshid -E- Barhakh Al-Hajj Hafiz Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) was born at Shitalu Sharif, at Sirikot of Hajara district of North-east frontier province of Pakistan in Flijri 1336, 1916 A.D. He is the son of Awlad-e-Rasul Kutubul Awlia Syed Ahmed Sirikoti (Radiyahallahu 'anh). He was the 40th Awlad-e-Rasul Sallallahu 'alayhi wa Sallam.

Religious Concern:

He was the follower of Ahle Sunnat Wal Jama't, Sunni in Belief, Hanafi in Mazhab, and Qaderiah in Silsilah.

Educational Life:

1. Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) became a Hafiz-e- Quran in 1927 at the age of 11, under his father's care. 2. He acquired deep knowledge in Tafsir, Hadith, Fiqh, Wassol, Naho, Saruf, Mantiq, Akaid, Hikmat; Falsafa (Philosophy), Ma'rifat, Tarikat, under his father adores teaching and special care. At the time of absence of his father far religious activity in abroad 3. He studied at Darul Uloom Islamia Rahmania at Haripur. 4. He acquired special knowledge in Tafsir and Hadith from Muhaddith-e-azam Pakistan Hazrat Sardar Ahmed Lyelpuri (Radiyahallahu 'anh). 5. Among his Teachers, two famous teachers were Hazrat Allama Hafiz Abdur Rahman (Radiyahallahu 'anh) And Hazrat Allama Abdul Hamid (Radiyahallahu 'anh).

Holy Character

Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) was an ideal in character. All beautiful admirable character was gathered in his holy personality.

Khilafat

He was declared as 'Khalifs-e- Azam' by his father Kutubul Awlia Syed Ahmed Sirikoti (Radiyahallahu 'anh) from the then East Pakistan (Now Bangladesh) in 1958 at the age of 42.

Appearance in Bangladesh:

1. Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) first came in Bangladesh in 1942 at the age of 26. In Chittagong he served the Imamat of Tarawih prayer at Andarkilla Shahi Jame Mosque. 2. Second time in 1958, at the age of 42 he came in Bangladesh and stayed in Engineer Abdul khaleq's residence in Chittagong. 3. Then from 1961 to 1971 & 1976 to 1981 he came in Bangladesh every year.

Religious Contribution:

1. Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) contributed in the progress of Sunniat from town to the remote part of Bangladesh, especially in Chittagong. 2. He spread Sunniat and Tariqa-e- Alia QUADERIAH in the Middle-East, Rangoon of Burma (Now Myanmar).

3. He patronized Jamea Ahmadia Sunnia Alia and many other Madrasah and mosque. He established many Madrasah in Pakistan and Bangladesh. Some are given below:

Organizational Contribution:

1. Hazrat Hafiz Quad Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah ((Radiyahallahu 'anh)) established Gausia Committee Bangladesh in 1986 for the establishment of Sunniat based society and also Majlishe Gausia Sirikotia in Pakistan. 2. He patronized Sunni Political Party Chatra Shena and other religious organization.

Jashne Julus-E-Eid-e-Milad un Nabi (Sallallahu 'alayhi wa Sallam):

Hazrat Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) was the pioneer of Jashne Julus-e- Eid-e-Milad -un- Nabi (Sallallahu 'alayhi wa Sallam) in Bangladesh.

Contribution to Publication:

1. Hazrat Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah ((Radiyahallahu 'anh)) ordered Anjuman-e-Rahmania Ahmadia Sunnia to publish Tarjuman in 1978, which is the representative of Sunni Jammat. 2. From 1986 Anwar- e- Mustafa (Sallallahu 'alayhi wa Sallam) began publishing according to his direction.

Implementation of Khatm- E- Gausia:

1. Hazrat Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) implemented Khatm-e-Gausia and ordered to observe it in every month in every

Sunni Mosque and Khankah. He also implemented Giaravi and Baravi Sharif. 2. Implementation of Sabse Awla o Ala and Mustafa-Jan -e-Rahmat 3. According to his direction 'Sabse Awla' is the assembly song of every Sunni Madrasah. He also ordered to implement the Salam 'Mustafa Jan- e -Rahmat' at Milad and Qiam which is widely established now.

Political Activity:

He was an active member of Pakistan movement. He was against the Pakistani oppression in the liberation war of Bangladesh in 1971. And said to Shah Ahmed Nurani the president of MMH & chairman of World Islamic mission, London to give pressure on Pakistani govt. to stop oppression and to have a political understanding.

Establishment of Mosque, Khankah and Patronization:

Hazrat Hafiz Quari Syed Muhammad Tayyab Shah (Radiyahallahu 'anh) established a large mosque in Sirikot. In Rangoon, Myanmar he established Khankah -e-quaderiah Syedia. His other establishments are Khankah- e-Qaderia Syedia Tayyebia at Bahar Signal, Alamgir Khankah Sharif at Jamia complex, Khankah-e-Syedia Tayyebia at Kayetuli, Dhaka.
